Grade 4/5

On Monday the grade 4/5's will all be participating in soapstone carving led by Oliver Harwood. I have also forwarded the email from the North Vancouver Outdoor School (Cheakamus Centre). If all goes as planned, the grade 4/5's hope to go to Brackendale to observe the bald eagles, attend the salmon hatchery and spend time in the Long House, making bannock and learning about the traditions of the First Nations.

The grade 4/5's are also entertaining inviting Elder Baker to talk to our students about the First Nations' relationship with the environment and animals.

Beginning the conversation about Residential Schools with the grade 4/5 team in order for our teachers to become informed and knowledgeable so that they can comprehensively teach our students through an inquiry-based unit in September of the 2015-2016 school year.
