#### **Rationale:**

### **Summary of proposed activities:**

Social Studies units at several grade levels

### Grade 1

- o fieldtrip to Grouse Mountain (long house)
- o Grade 1 visit from Faye Halls from the Squamish Nation to talk about seasons and family

### Grade 3

- Social Studies The government of local Aboriginals (including elections, and management of their political issues) with a comparison between the municipal government of West Vancouver and that of the local native government.
- Science the solar system with emphasis on the constellations from a North American and Aboriginal viewpoint.
- Further units on Structures and Plants will cover a comparison and discussion from their viewpoint.
- Language Pauline Johnson was discussed as being a poet and the namesake of PJ.
- Social Studies Isaac Van der Horst, the curator of the West Van Museum is being invited to do a presentation to the students including a discussion of Pauline Johnson and the municipality in the 19th century.
- Art native art will be discussed (design etc)
