DONATIONS: Excellent, like new, and new condition items accepted. All donations should be CLEAN, complete, free of holes/rips/tears, and must be in good working order. Friends and family can donate, too, so long as items meet the standards above.

Wanna go the extra mile? Put anything that is a set or should remain together (PJ's, toys, chargers, etc) together in a CLEAR plastic bag. Size /description labels are a huge help, especially on shoes!

SUPPLIES: anything that helps us display items and advertise the sale throughout the community. Ideas are:

- tables • shelving • poster board • garment racks • hangers (kid and adult) • tarps • ladders (for displaying clothing and shoes) • small round pricing stickers • packing tape • wooden or metal stakes • balloons • and BAGS! (reusable or plastic that we can provide on yard sale day)

BAKED GOODS: A good way to get the kids involved!

- cupcakes • lemonade • coffee • bottled water • freezies • cookies • popcorn • brownies • rice crispy treats • popsicles • any other yummy treat!

VOLUNTEERS: ~~the more people we have to help out,~~ the better we can make the yard sale look, the better we can market it, and the more successful we can be! Even if you only have a few hours, your help would be appreciated!

Timeline:

June 24-27: drop off donations in BOYS locker room beside gymnasium during school hours

Thur, August 29: 9am - 4pm.
Drop off donations, organize, and price!

Fri, August 30 & Sat, August 31:

7am - put up neighborhood yard sale signs, help with unloading/moving of large items (dads!)

8am - 9am: set up on site

9am - 1pm: Yard Sale

1-2pm: move items back to gym / prep items for donation
