Cypress mountain is only 20 minutes from West Vancouver's town centre and is a great place for snow sports and amazing city views. Whistler is a top-rated skiing and snowboarding destination and is only a 90-minute drive away.



THE BEST PLACE IN THE WORLD

British Columbia, Canada's westernmost province, borders the Pacific Ocean. HOW TO APPLY

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

In Canada, the academic year runs from September to June, with short holidays in December and March. West Vancouver Schools' International Programs select a limited number of students each year. Students are admitted in September and February, but prospective students must apply well in advance to ensure they can be offered a seat in our program.
