#### **Recruitment and Staffing Update**

Recent staffing changes were highlighted, including the appointment of Liz Hill as Assistant Superintendent.

Retention rates for Education Assistants this year have been strong, which can be attributed to the changing labour market and the valuable contributions of the two newly added Inclusion Leads. Concluding the pilot initiative for the Inclusion Leads, the HR team is excited to announce a 2-year secondment opportunity for three EA Team Leads starting this September.

#### French Immersion Recruitment Initiatives

The district received an increase in funding from the Federal French Growth Fund that will help enhance the French Immersion Program and support students at both the elementary and secondary levels.
