1.	2023-2024 Playground Award
	Rockridge Secondary School will be the recipient of this year's \$10,000 district playground grant (\$5k funding, \$5k work in kind), which will assist the PAC to refurbish the school's outdoor basketball court, including resurfacing, logo application and new backboards.
2.	West Vancouver Place for Sports Update
	This week marked the commencement of heavy trucking activity at the site. Thorough preparations for traffic and safety plans have been efficiently coordinated with the contractor and project manager.

3.	Gleneagles Retaining Wall
	Director of Facilities Street conveyed that the District just received the draft design for the retaining wall remediation from geotechnical engineers. In collaboration with his team and insurers, they will conduct a comprehensive review of the design in order to finalize the plan and apply for a building permit. Mr. Street will be meeting with a structural engineer to ensure safety and security of the portable structure during the ongoing work in the area. The childcare provider should be able to reoccupy the affected portable within the next few months.

4.	Winter Weather
	Director of Facilities Street and his team were kept busy over the past weekend addressing issues related to burst water pipes at both Chartwell and Sentinel locations. The Facilities team and, a loyal contractor, successfully fixed the issues and restored the affected areas, working well into the early morning hours. Their commitment ensured that all sites were fully operational for the return of staff and student son Monday.
	Secretary-Treasurer Leiterman commended Director of Facilities Street and his team for their hard work, acknowledging their efforts from the identification of the problem, its resolutions, to the implementation of preventive measures against future challenges.
5.	2023-2024 Amended Budget - Funding
	Secretary-Treasurer Leiterman provided an overview of the amended annual budget revenue for the 2023-24 school year. The District will experience an estimated revenue increase of \$890k due to the increase in full-time enrolment.
