Deputy Superintendent Hill reported on the school district's 1701 process, which is conducted in accordance with the School and Student Data Collection Order. This information is essential for several purposes, including the allocation of funds to boards, tracking student movement between schools, monitoring enrolment trends in various programs, and providing summaries of school data.

Enrolment remains strong, marking the highest local enrolment figures ever recorded for West Vancouver Schools, as well as a greater-than-expected number of fee-paying students this year.
