1. West Vancouver Place for Sport Update

Project updates were shared, including continued progress on washrooms, which are nearing completion, fully renovated, and accessible to the public. Bleachers have been painted, with costs covered by the Municipality. The rubber base has been laid on the asphalt, with work underway on the red topcoat.

Completion remains weather-dependent, with a target date of July 7.

2. West Vancouver Football Club Bubble Update

The Soccer Bubble project is moving ahead, with construction set to begin shortly. A groundbreaking ceremony is scheduled for June 25 and will include the Mayor and the project's donor.

3. Early Childhood Education Centre

The project continues to progress well, with excavation and trucking nearly complete. The foundation and concrete crew are scheduled to begin shortly.

Early geotechnical assessments proved accurate, eliminating the need for deeper digging and escalated costs. The project remains on track for completion between mid-fall and the end of the year.
