2020 Ministry of Education Student Learning Survey

The School District #45 is participating in the 2020 Ministry of Education Student Learning Survey (formally called the Satisfaction Survey) with all other school districts throughout the province. The Survey is unique in its scope, size and usefulness to schools, as it gathers information from parents, teachers and students on topics related to school environment, safety, and achievement. The information is used for planning in individual schools, and provides a district and provincial perspective.

The Student Learning Survey will be administered to students in grades 10 and 12, their parents/Guardians, and all school staff. We encourage parents to participate in this survey, as the results are important in identifying and celebrating current strengths, as well as determining where the school needs to focus improvement.

Parents/Guardians of Grades 10 and 12 students can complete the anonymous Internet electronic surveys any time **before April 3, 2020.**

To complete the survey:

- 1. Go to www.bced.gov.bc.ca/sat survey/access.htm.
- 2. Select the "Direct Access" option
- 3. Select "45 West Vancouver" from the District drop down list.
- 4. Select "West Vancouver Secondary" from the School drop down list.
- 5. Choose your preferred language from the drop-down list.
- 6. Complete the survey by clicking the green NEXT in the bottom right corner of the screen.
- 7. When you are finished, the message "Thank you for sharing your views" will appear.

<u>Graduation LITERACY Assessment (GLA10): Grade 10 students –</u> April 14,15,16,17,20, 2020

All WVSS Grade 10 students will be writing the Graduation Literacy Assessment (GLA 10) this April at West Vancouver Secondary school. This assessment is required for graduation purposes. *Please avoid any planned absences April 14- 20th as all Grade 10 students need to write this assessment in the April <i>exam session.* The exam schedule, by last name, will be provided in the next few weeks.

Students should prepare for this exam. It is important that students try their best and take this assessment seriously. All grade 10 students should try the sample exams (printed or online) and review the scoring guide.
