Welcome back from what will undoubtedly be a Spring Break we will all remember for a long time. I hope that you and your families are healthy and safe as we move into unfamiliar territory with regards to the remainder of our 2020 school year. This is uncharted territory for all of us and we will be doing everything we can to support the students and families of our school community.

Earlier this week, Superintendent Kennedy sent out a letter to all West Vancouver Schools families outlining our district's plan to ensure a *Continuity of Learning* for our students. We will continue to provide regular updates as planning develops and additional information becomes available.

### **Timelines for March 30 - April 3**

- Next week staff will be reconnecting, planning and building their capacity to provide opportunities for learning remotely.
- By mid-week, your child and/or you can expect communication from their teacher(s) to check-in.
- By Friday of next week, we are hoping that teachers will be in a position to provide students and families with a general learning overview for week twofocusing on essential learning.

- Maintain physical distancing and follow public health guidelines
