Youth Training in Trades Carpentry Program – 4 Spots Left!

The Youth Train In Trades (YTT) Carpentry Program provides training for Grade 11 and 12 students interested in a career in carpentry and related trades. Based at West Vancouver Secondary, students receive training every second day, while attending their own secondary school for core academic subjects.

The Youth Train In Trades program is a dual-credit program which means students receive 16 credits (4 courses) towards high school graduation in addition to Level 1 Carpentry training and Work-Based

Training hours credited toward apprenticeship and eventual journeyman certification. This technical training is typically done at a post-secondary institution with associated tuition and materials costs, and this program is offered to high school students for significantly reduced costs as it is part of their Graduation Program. Each student is registered as a trainee with the ITA.

Attendance/Student Contact Tracking During Remote Learning

The Ministry of Education has instructed schools to keep a basic record of "Attendance/Contact" with students over the course of remote learning. Teachers and schools have the responsibility to track and report student contact in order to ensure students are safe and receiving opportunities for ongoing learning. Student contact is defined as a two-way communication between teacher and student/parents. If teachers are unable to connect with a student remotely during the week, the teachers or a school staff member will be reaching out to families to ensure students are receiving communication and have what they need in order to continue with remote learning.
