Literacy at BICS:

We are excited to share more about our targeted reading instruction that is happening in Grades K-5 this year. Our staff and students are feeling more confident with the UFLI (University of Florida Literacy Institute) Foundations program, and we are seeing gains being made with all students. UFLI follows a carefully developed scope and sequence, which is designed to ensure that students systematically acquire each skill needed and learn to apply each skill with automaticity and confidence. The program is designed to be used for core instruction in the primary grades. At school, students are placed in groups based on their current skill level and receive targeted instruction 3 times a week. Roll and Read is a game that is a part of the UFLI program that may be sent home in your child's home reading bag. The roll and reads that come home are to reinforce skills learned each week at school.

On Thursday, February 6th, Mary Parackal, District Vice-Principal of Early Learning, will return to BICS to share additional games and strategies families can use to support readers at home. Staff will also share a UFLI lesson and answer questions you might have. Please feel free to join us at 8:35am for some snacks and coffee and then the parent workshop to follow.
