## Admissions 2020-21

Online applications for student admissions for the 2020-2021 school year will be accepted as of 8 am on Tuesday, October 15<sup>th</sup>.

Applications will be accepted for <u>ALL</u> Kindergarten applications (in-catchment, out of catchment and out of district) and for <u>IN-CATCHMENT</u> applicants in Grades 1 – 12.

#### Registration for High School

If your first choice high school is **Rockridge**, you are not required to complete an online application (regardless of where you live). **Rockridge** counsellors will be visiting schools in late winter/early spring and distributing transfer forms at that time.

HOWEVER, if your first choice for secondary school is somewhere other than Rockridge, you must complete an online application according to the <u>student</u> <u>registration timelines</u>. **Please note:** No out of catchment or out of district applications for secondary are accepted until January.

## **Halloween Activities**







Though this year's Halloween celebrations will look a little different, we will still be having some Covid-friendly Halloween fun in classrooms this year. In lieu of our annual Primary Pumpkin Patch, Caulfeild has decided to combine our love of Halloween traditions and books all into one! The Intermediate students will be asked to design and decorate a pumpkin based on a book character. Once decorated, these pumpkins will be displayed for primary grades to view and enjoy.

As well, on Friday, October 30th students will have the option of dressing in their Halloween costume for the day. Should your child choose to wear a costume, they will need to come dressed in the morning. Unfortunately, due to Covid restrictions, bathrooms are not available for changing or makeup application. Please make sure costumes are suitable for school and comfortable enough to be in all day through various activities. School rules are that no Halloween masks, inflatable costumes, or accessories such as weapons are permitted. Also, please be aware that food is not being shared and no treats are to come into classrooms. Fortunately, because we are a digital school, a slideshow of classroom costumes will be created in order that students get to see all the creative and wonderful characters that our Caulfeild bears will become.

# **Timely Arrival**

Thank you for assisting your child to arrive at school on time. Schedules and routines are an extremely important part of our Health and Safety procedures. Classes are led into the building one cohort at a time for careful hand sanitization. Late arrivals add a complexity to this procedure we hope to mitigate ????

K-2 students are expected to be dropped off at school between 8:20 and **8:30am** - Teachers take their classes into the build at 8:30. If you are not in the line at that time your child will be marked late.

3-5 student arrive time 8:30-8:40

6-7 students arrive time 8:40-**8:50** 

## Procedure for Late Arrivals and Early Pick-Ups

Though we strongly encourage students to arrive and leave school during their scheduled times, we understand that there are occasionally extenuating circumstances that cannot be helped. When that is the case please follow the guidelines below:

**Late Arrivals:** Students needing to arrive late are asked to come at the end of one of the two outdoor recess breaks and enter with their class.

Kindergarten to Grade 3 at 10:30 am or 12:20 pm.

Grades 4 to 7 at 10:55 am or 1:00 pm.

**Early Pick-Ups:** Students needing to leave early are asked to leave at the beginning of one of the two outdoor recess breaks and exit through the main doors to be picked up at the top of the roundabout.

Kindergarten to Grade 3 at 10:10am or 12:00pm.

Grades 4 to 7 at 10:35 am or 12:40 pm.

## **Procedure for Student Absence**

If your child will be absent we ask that you inform the office before classes begin, either by email to <a href="mailto:caulfeild@wvschools.ca">caulfeild@wvschools.ca</a> or by leaving a voicemail at 604-981-1205. Please be sure to inform the office even if you have already notified your child's teacher.

## School Forms are PAST DUE

Thank you to everyone that has already completed their forms. If you have not returned your child's emergency forms please do so as soon as possible as these are required in order to release your child in the event of an emergency.

To date we have only received **54%** of the online <u>Policies and Procedures</u> form, we need to reach 100%. This online form is required for students to participate fully in classroom and school activities. Without a completed Policies and Procedures form your child will not be able to participate in the upcoming Terry Fox Runs.
