Our Whole School Inquiry

When we return from March break all our divisions from K-7 will be engaging in our second whole school inquiry of the year.

Our staff have been working from this big idea: There are many great people in our community from present day and through history who possess and demonstrate qualities that we value and identify as Being the Bear. As we explore these people and ideas we will examine our 14 Bear Traits and REP skills with the goal of streamlining our school values.

From there, we have developed our essential question: Which of our Bear Traits best measure a person's ability to make a positive difference in their community?

There will be more details to come about this important and valuable inquiry learning structure that is a unique iDEC learning experience.

Dismissal and After School Play

- 3. "Staff and other adults should seek to reduce the number of close, face-to-face interactions with each other at all times, even if wearing a non-medical mask." Pg. 13, Physical Distancing, Bullet #5

A message from our Superintendent, Chris Kennedy: [On Tuesday it was] announced that the running track at West Vancouver Secondary will be named "The Harry Jerome Oval". Harry Jerome is one of Canada's most celebrated athletes who grew up on the North Shore and competed on our track in the late 1950's. Harry went on to set seven world spring records and represented Canada at three Olympic Games.

The West Vancouver Place for Sport will replace West Vancouver Secondary School's existing grass

field and deteriorated track with an artificial turf field and new track which will support our students, sporting clubs and athletic organizations.
