

Students are not required to wear a mask when outside; i.e. when coming to school; recess; lunch; pick-up; and for outdoor learning and outdoor PE. There are other exceptions (e.g. when eating or drinking) noted

### Masks can be temporarily removed for music (i.e. playing an instrument). At iDEC, our students in band play in a large space allowing for more than 2m physical distancing.






