

Taking our Learning Outdoors


Above is a look at some of the learning activities we have been doing outside this week. Caulfeild and our surrounding community is a wonderful place to learn and grow. During this next term, we will be making the most of the opportunities to take our learning outdoors. Our staff are using a sign out system to maximize the use of our school grounds throughout the day while ensuring our cohorts have their own space and are not mixing with others.

Next week we will have some of our divisions participating in the West Vancouver Mayor's Clean Up Challenge. Division 12 with Ms. Prins and Ms. Seward got an early jump on this community cleanup challenge yesterday that even included a local shoreline cleanup.

Journal writing, reading, physical activity & physical literacy, mathematical exploration, art and so much more await our Bears outside this term. Rest assured, our teachers are planning lessons that are appropriate for children to be outside and do not take away from the term three goals of the classroom with regard to numeracy, literacy and inquiry. As always, the staff at iDEC do not disappoint and are always on the leading edge of what learning needs to look like . . . even in a pandemic.

Our Whole School Inquiry: *Heroes Walk Among Us*

All our divisions from K-7 are coming to the conclusion of our second whole school inquiry of the year. Just ask your child tonight: **What Bear Traits are the most common ones in your division?** or **What have you learned about your hero/leader?**

Students will make connections with these stories of others and how they use our Bear Traits to achieve their goals and make a difference all while solving an important problem for the Caulfeild Bear . . . he is having a hard time remembering the 14 Bear Traits!

Health and Safety - Quick Facts for you to Easily Scan

- The staff at Caulfeild take the health and safety of our students and learning community members very seriously.
- A reminder that our school playgrounds are closed for after school play. This rule is in place to reduce the risk of crowding and cohorts mixing in close range. You are welcome to return to the lower playground after 3:30pm. Our upper playgrounds are used by our after school programs and are not open for public use until 6:00pm.

- We have good news that Vancouver Coastal Health is announcing a vaccination program for all school district staff in the Vancouver Coastal Health authority (*this includes West Vancouver Schools*) that will begin this weekend. It is expected to take approximately 5 weeks to vaccinate all staff through this program.






