Professional Day Monday - No School for Students



Google Classroom:

An important digital platform for supporting student learning across all grades at iDEC is Google Classroom. Reviewing your child's Google Classroom is a supportive activity you and your child should do together. Here's a short video, just 3 minutes long, that explains how to look at your child's Google Classroom. It outlines how to navigate assignments that are posted for your child. It also provides an explanation of how to see what assignments are done, which ones have been returned and which ones are missing.

Remember, parents are not members of the Google Classroom, you need to log in together on your child's account. Your child's teacher can answer any questions you may have. 
Performing a Daily Health Check: Families should continue to perform the <u>Daily Health Check</u> daily health check with your child(ren) prior to drop off each morning. If your child is not feeling well, please do not send them to school. VCH recommends that you can also use the <u>K-12 health-checker app</u>.

Thank you Caulfeild families for your commitment to mask safety measures. We would ask that families continue to help their child come prepared with their own mask, and an extra each day.

Secondary Transitions

Last Friday our grade seven students had some special guests speak to them about transitioning to secondary school. Vice-Principal Towers and two past iDEC students, Leo and Luca hosted presentations to Division 1 and 2.

Procedure for Late Arrivals and Early Pick-Up

Though we strongly encourage students to arrive and leave school during their scheduled times, we understand that there are occasionally extenuating circumstances that cannot be helped. When that is the case please follow the guidelines below:

Late Arrivals: Students needing to arrive late are asked to come at the end of one of the two outdoor recess breaks. They are to check in at the office then enter with their class.

Kindergarten to Grade 3: 10:30 am or 12:40 pm Grades 4 to 7: 10:30 am or 1:00 pm

Early Pick-Ups: Students needing to leave early are asked to leave at the beginning of one of the two outdoor recess breaks. They are to check out at the office, then exit through the main doors to be picked up at the top of the roundabout.

Kindergarten to Grade 3: 10:10 am or 12:00 pm

Grades 4 to 7: 10:10 am or 12:40 pm

We thank you for your cooperation in following these procedures as they help minimize classroom disruption, as well as, ensure that health & safety protocols are followed as students enter and leave the school.

If you are a girl in Grade 6 or 7 who attends a West Vancouver School and you are interested in coding, this club might be for you!


Just click on the poster to enlarge it for details on how to register and for further details. This is a weekly club that takes place in the evening.
