

immunization clinic on Wednesday this week, Anna will finish her last day with us on Monday next week.





Though we strongly encourage students to arrive and leave school during their scheduled times, we

understand that there are occasionally extenuating circumstances that cannot be helped. When that is the case please email Ms. Chung jchung@wvschools.ca and follow the guidelines below. Please also keep in mind that the staff at iDEC want all our learners in K to 7 to have the best possible start to their school day. We ask families to ensure that their children are arriving to school on time. Schedules and routines


