

This message is to request your help with our daily dismissal procedures. In order that we have a safe,

If you are meeting your child on the school grounds (and not picking them up by car), please talk to your child and set a designated spot for your child to meet you (see map below for possible meet up areas). This way your child will consistently know where to look to see if you are there.

Admissions for ALL Kindergarten registrations (in-catchment, out of catchment and out of district) and for <u>IN-CATCHMENT</u> registrations in Grades 1-12 will be open on Monday, October 17th. Please note

If your first choice high school is Rockridge, you are not required to complete an online application (regardless of where you live). Rockridge counsellors will be visiting schools in late winter/early spring

HOWEVER, if your first choice for secondary school is somewhere other than Rockridge, you must complete an online application according to the student registration timelines. Please note: No out of

**Bringing Your Own Cutlery**





We thank you for your cooperation in following these procedures as they help minimize classroom

There are two signs along Caulfeild Dr. that indicate the drivers need to save space for accessible parking. This is especially important during drop off and pick up. If someone is not parked in the accessible parking spot, this does not mean that it is available to families who do not require access. We

have a number of families that do require accessible parking, they have been identified by the school, and these spots are reserved for them. Thank you for understanding. Drop off and pick up is going well, but we do need to share a few reminders. First, please refrain from

parking in teacher spots, even temporarily, during this time. We also cannot be in the habit of parking or stopping our cars in the roundabout. The roundabout should always be moving. If you need to park for




