

# Survey for the Ministry of Education and Child Care

We know that many families depend on school-age child care to ensure their children have a quality, affordable,

and inclusive place to be during a parent's full work day. That is why the Province's ChildCareBC plan is working to expand access to child care for all families that want and need it.

The Ministry of Education and Child Care is conducting a parent survey to better understand the regional and

provincial demand for school age child care. While we know there is unmet demand for school-aged child care, there is no current provincial or regional data quantifying the demand. Your participation will help the Province plan for future school-aged child care

expansions. Who should fill out this survey? If you have children attending Kindergarten to Grade 7 at a B.C. school, we

want to hear from you about your family's child care needs. What will this survey be used for? The survey results will be used to support planning for future initiatives under the ChildCareBC plan. All responses are voluntary and anonymous; you and your child will not be

identified as a result of your participation in the survey. Information received will be combined and shared with your school and district as a summary. How do I complete the survey? 
