Learning at iDEC

Hello Families,

Today we will be launched our December Whole School Inquiry that focuses on the question: How can we use our leadership skills to create an inclusive school community? Student leaders in Grades 6 and 7 worked in Multi-Age Groups with students from every grade to lead an activity and model inclusion. Students K-7 were given the opportunity to use their personal strengths to create a creative and funny scene together. These groups are a fantastic way to nurture our school community while focusing on student leadership.

The Santa Sale is tomorrow! Thank you to all of our parent volunteers who have been working hard for weeks to make this happen tomorrow, Dec 8th. Students can bring some money to shop for a loved one, and primary students have the support of their big buddy to do so.

The Scholastic Book Fair was a great success this year! We exceeded our \$9,000 goal for total sales of \$13,219! Thank you to the 25+ parent volunteers and the CPAC for helping to make this happen! Parents donated 78 books and the Rewards money added an additional 32 books, for a total of 110 books for classroom libraries. In addition to 48 books purchased at the Fair, we earned \$1,000 in Scholastic Dollars and \$2,000 in cash to buy books and other items for the Library for the coming year.







Learning Updates

As we approach the winter break, we also approach the time in which we share our first formal learning update (report cards), which will be posted to the Family Portal by the end of the day on Friday, December 22nd. We wanted to ensure you were informed of some of the changes that you may notice to previous learning updates as the province adapts the format of our communication to best meet the needs of our learners and families.

Formal learning updates and summary of learning: This is the first of two learning updates for this school year. These are shared in the first and second term and reflect how students are doing in each term. The term three report is a summary of learning which is based on learning from the whole school year. These reports are highly personalized and are written specifically for each learner, they are written in the language of what students can do.

Informal learning updates: There are two informal learning conferences each year. One was completed in term one in the form of parent-teacher conferences and one will be completed at the end of term two.


Proficiency scale: Although we are continuing to use the proficiency scale, we are using it in a slightly different way. You will notice an overall proficiency for each subject area accompanied by individualized comments on how the learners are doing within the subject. Please ensure you read the individualized comments, and beyond just looking at the proficiency, to best understand how your child is doing. In West Vancouver, PROFICIENT is the goal for most students, this shows a complete understanding and application of the curriculum.

Curriculum: The learning updates shared are skill and competency based, for a better understanding of the specific content areas, please refer to the B.C. curriculum, found here

Parents as partners: We value the wonderful partnerships and relationships we have with our parent community here at Caulfeild. To further support this, we continue to include specific ways to support our learners in their learning updates. These may be found either within the specific content areas or in the "Areas for Future Growth and Learning" section of the learning update.

Instead, the student is able to demonstrate their learning consistently or most of the time.
