Based Digitally Enhanced Community. This is the cornerstone of our learning. Thanks to CPAC initiatives, each primary student at Caulfeild has access to an iPAD. Our intermediate students use devices to connect to our world and share their learning.

Our Digital Design class, a unique opportunity for students in West Vancouver, teaches our intermediate students how to write code, practice digital animation, edit movies and more. Our technology infused spaces support deep engagement with Inquiry. Our teachers use their collaboration time to plan engaging, cross curricular units of Inquiry, and our learning spaces reflect the "community" aspect of that learning. Our coworking classrooms reflect how much we value collaborating, critical thinking, creativity and trust. Our iDEC model is celebrated for advancing our students knowledge and engagement with their digital world and the world around them. Tomorrow is Orange Shirt Day. Foundational Skills Assessment

Statutory Holiday September 30, 2024 The day honours the lost children and Survivors of residential schools, their families and communities. Public

commemoration of the tragic and painful history and ongoing impacts of residential schools is a vital component of the reconciliation process. The creation of this federal statutory holiday was through legislative amendments made by Parliament. On June 3, 2021, Bill C-5, An Act to amend the Bills of Exchange Act, the Interpretation Act and the Canada Labour Code (National Day for Truth and Reconciliation) received Royal Assent. Caulfeild iDEC and all West Vancouver Schools also showed our support to honour Truth & Reconciliation by wearing ORANGE on Friday Sept 27. This week, staff and students engaged in conversations and learning around Truth and Reconciliation. Families are invited and encouraged to continue these discussions and learning at home, especially on October 2nd. Huy chexw

Cross Country Meets are held at Ambleside on Tuesday Oct 1st. Parents are responsible for arranging transportation to and from the meets. They end promptly at 5:00, though some races will occur earlier, so arriving early is suggested. The order for races is typically; Grade 7,3, 4, 5, 6. Children do not have to remain at the Meet after their run and can leave before 5:00 if they sign out with a teacher. Remember to wear Bear Wear or a Red T-shirt to the meet!

Pick Up and Drop Off: Important Reminders

All students in K-7 will be dismissed at 2:30 pm, except on Wednesdays when we dismiss at 2:00. For orderly and

quick dismissal, please park using the street parking and walk to the designated pick-up space near the top of the roundabout. With all students dismissed together, the driving through the roundabout should only be used by families who absolutely need to remain in the car, with priority for primary students, as we expect lineups to be busy and long. If your child is not ready (outside and waiting), we may need to move you along and out of the line in order to keep traffic moving. Please DO NOT stop for pick up and drop off at the north side crosswalk on Caulfeild Drive. This is a no stopping

zone because stopping puts students in dangerous situations. There are places to stop preceding and following the


