Learning at iDEC

Hello Families,

This week, our school was featured in a **School Board presentation.** Each year, schools share something they're proud of with the Board. On Tuesday, Mr. Blackburn, Ms. McLeod, Ms. Parker, and Emerald from Division 4 highlighted how we've been building connections with our local community. This year, classrooms have supported organizations like Santa for Seniors, North Shore Search and Rescue, and The Harvest Project. Most recently, Division 4 visited Backpack Buddies and helped prepare over 800 baskets for families in need.

Student safety at drop-off and pick-up continues to be a concern. Please cross at the crosswalks and avoid unsafe drop-offs. We've had several dangerous situations near the school. If you're able to volunteer to help monitor these areas and support student safety, please reach out. Keep your speed low and stay alert near the school. We are in a school zone, and the West Vancouver Police Department will be conducting traffic enforcement. We all share the responsibility of keeping our students safe.

Today was the start of the grade 5 **Reading Link Challenge!** Teams competed for a shot at the district competition. Next week, **Elevate Ultimate** is coming to work with students in the intermediate divisions to build their skills. Thank you to CPAC for making it happen! Our Ultimate games continue next week on Tuesday after school at Ridgeview.

Student Learning Surveys To complete the survey, which takes approximately 30 minutes, please follow the steps below: 1. Click here. You do not require a Logon # to access the parent survey. 2. Select the District (45 West Vancouver), School and language of preference and then click Log 3. On. Complete the survey by clicking on the appropriate bubbles. 4. Your survey has been submitted directly to the Ministry of Education when the window states, 5. "Thank you for sharing your views." Your responses are voluntary and anonymous, and your child will not be identified as a result of your participation in the survey. Any personal or identifying information will be deleted before results are stored. Data will be stored and accessible only within Canada. The survey closes on May 2, 2025. Personal Digital Device Expectations

As we begin a new term, we'd like to remind students and families of our **Personal Digital Device (PDD) expectations**, which have been key to fostering focused and engaging learning environments.

Students are expected to use personal digital devices only with the explicit permission of a teacher or administrator, ensuring their use is intentional and supports learning.

Families can continue to support this by:

- Encouraging balanced screen time at home.
- Avoiding calls or texts to students during school hours.
- Modeling mindful device use when on school property and at home.

Let's keep building on the success of this initiative and continue supporting safe, focused learning for all!

Pick Up and Drop Off: Important Reminders

All students in K-7 will be dismissed at 2:30 pm, except on Wednesdays when we dismiss at 2:00. For orderly and quick dismissal, please park using the street parking and walk to the designated pick-up space near the top of the roundabout. With all students dismissed together, the driving through the roundabout should only be used by families who absolutely need to remain in the car, with priority for primary students, as we expect lineups to be busy and long. If your child is not ready (outside and waiting), we may need to move you along and out of the line in order to keep traffic moving.

• Please DO NOT stop for pick up and drop off at the north side crosswalk on Caulfeild Drive. This is a no stopping zone because stopping puts students in dangerous situations. There are places to stop preceding and following the crosswalk. Check for signage. WVPD will support periodic enforcement of this area.

• Car (Gr. 7): Please use parking spaces along Caulfeild Drive so your child can safely enter your vehicle. Do not stop on Caulfeild Drive unless there is a parking space available. Please reserve at least two parking spaces near the front for students and families with accessibility needs.

Daily Health Checks

Parents are asked to do daily health checks of children before sending children to school. As flu and cold season is still upon us, we ask for your assistance to ensure that your child is healthy and well enough to participate in normal school activities. If your child is unwell, please report their absence through the school email at <u>caulfeild@wvschools.ca</u> or the Call Back Line at 604 981 1205. Parents are also reminded that communicable diseases should be reported to your classroom teacher and to the school office. This would include chicken pox, measles, etc. While not a communicable disease, we also ask that students and families report any cases of lice to the office. When we have a report, we can take some preventative measures within our community and classrooms.

Outdoor pickleball courts and pump track proposed near Gleneagles Community Centre

The District of West Vancouver is exploring the idea of constructing four outdoor pickleball courts and a new paved pump track near the Gleneagles Community Centre (GECC) to enhance recreation opportunities for residents in the western part of the community. This proposal could involve replacing the existing Bike Terrain Park and Skateboard Bowl located north of GECC.

The design for this proposal is in its preliminary phase and may be modified based on input from the community. The District of West Vancouver are seeking your feedback to help shape this potential project.
