Planning Ahead: Enrollment 2025 / 2026 Over the coming months, Caulfeild iDEC teachers will configure students into classes for the 2025-2026 school year. THIS FORM is an opportunity for parents to share information they feel should be considered when placing their child for the next school year. This form is optional.

The class placement process is very complex as teachers consider the individual needs of students as well as group dynamics. When placing students, school personnel consider teachers' observations of individual needs and social dynamics, input from support staff, class size and composition (learning and behavior needs, gender), and learning styles. Parent feedback is valued and will be considered, but it is important for families to know that there are many other

factors that affect the placement of students and teachers' observations drive placement decisions. The last day to

As families and children come to our community, it is our responsibility to to provide space for them at school. This

means that many divisions will move to being multi-age classrooms in 2025/2026. Caulfeild teachers are experienced teaching in multi-age classrooms, it is part of our heritage, and our collaborative structures and schedules make us uniquely positioned to do it very well. Research also shows that there are significant, positive effects on student achievement with multi age classrooms. As we begin a new term, we'd like to remind students and families of our **Personal Digital Device (PDD) expectations**, which


