Q & A about the Red Carpet Event

Here are some answers to some of your questions:

- 1. What do I wear? Answer, it is a dress- up cocktail style event! iWhatever you would wear to a nice evening out would be appropriate.
- Will there be food and drinks at the event? Yes, there will be wine, beer and non alcoholic beverages for sale but your ticket includes appie style foods that some parents and CPAC are donating. Foods such as such as sushi, cheese/meat platters, and desserts.
- 3. How can I help make the event successful? You can help by donating a bottle of wine and a bottle of beer for our two raffles. You can bring the bottles to the school office and leave with Mrs McKaylee or Mrs K at the front office. We will be selling raffle tickets for two beverage baskets and the two winners will take home two baskets full of beverages.

You can also help by bringing in new items to sell at the auction such as beauty baskets, clothing, jewellery, toys, chocolates, food baskets, décor items, sports memorabilia or gift certificates for services such as restaurants, spa, fitness, children's classes, or tickets to events, etc. If you have any items, please bring to the office with your name clearly marked, the name of the donor, and the value of the item. We are re-attaching the letter of asking which you might ask a business you frequent.

- 4. Do I need to pay for the items in cash? You can pay for your beverages and the raffle tickets or any items you choose to buy by cash or cheque.
- 5. How does the silent auction work? Let us say there is a restaurant gift certificate for \$50 A sheet of paper describing the certificate with the name of the donor will be present. Bids would start at \$25 and whoever bids the highest amount wins the product and pays at the end of the night along with their other purchases if any. if you choose to bid on an item in the silent auction , only the final bidder wins so you must keep checking on your item that your name is the last one. The auction will close at 9:30 PM sharp and you will no longer be able to bid after that time.
- 6. Will there be entertainment? Definitely! Professional Bollywood entertainers from Shiamak and an A- Cappella group with our own Ms Laura Marshall have donated their time to entertain everyone!
- 7. Do I have to be present to win an item or a raffle? No, if you have to leave early and your name is still the last bidder then we would call you the next day and you would still be the final purchaser of the auction item. Also, if you are unable to attend, you can ask a friend or any member of the PAC to bid for you (we will send a final shopping list closer to the date so that you can know before hand what is for sale)
- 8. What is the Kids Art Sale? Each division with the guidance with one of our parent volunteers, Mahsa Heidari, will be producing a large piece of art which will be auctioned live at the event ! Any parent can put up their hand and buy the piece as a memory for their child's year at Chartwell!
