Chair report – Nessa van Bergen

 - Kylie Chen takes over the Coffee Club from Shelley Horsfield.

- 2. **Motion on spending Casino Funds.** Motion to give \$615.47 from Casino Funds to school for buying recess/sports equipment or jerseys. All in favor, motion carried unanimously.
- 3. Hot Lunch Information Session and Volunteer Orientation. Thanks to Natalia Rosales who provided an Information session on how to order the hot lunch: questions were clarified; technical problems were fixed. Thanks to Stephanie who provided demonstration to parents on how to work as hot lunch volunteers on the first two hot lunch days.
- 4. **Welcome Tea.** CPAC welcomed all parents back to school at the beginning of new school year. With Nessa's absence, the other members had great team work to offer a successful Welcome Tea. Tamzyn organized the event. Jennifer prepared the food and beverage. Joanne gave the welcome speech.
- 5. **Class parents** of each class have been identified and confirmed. The class email lists have been forwarded to each class parents from the Office.

- Curriculum Night. It was a wonderful night that parents met with principle and classroom teachers at the Curriculum Night. It's highly appreciated that Mme. Trudeau organized the great informative event.

Principle Report – Chantal Trudeau

1. **Staffing and Enrollment:** 238 students in 10 divisions this year. Very smooth start up. We have a new Band teacher who joined our staff, Ms. Rose Mary Lim. 36 students in Grade 6 and 7 Band.



- 2. **Meet the teacher Night:** I was very pleased with the turn out for this session. I hope that parents found it informative.
- 3. **Terry Fox Run:** nearly \$600 raised for the Terry Fox Foundation with our toonie drive! \$593.91 to be exact. Online donations were also accepted online so we do not know the Chartwell total. Great assembly and run last Thursday.
- 4. **Cross Country:** our team participated with enthusiasm in practices and meets. Last meet today. Thanks to Ms. Misener and Ms. Johnston for coaching our students. Thanks also to Ms. Fidai, Ms. Dhillon and Ms. Poe for marshalling.
- 5. **Basketball:** starting very soon with our first game on October 18th. If you know a basketball expert who can help us out with practices, he/she could contact me at ctrudeau@wvschools.ca and we would welcome the coaching help.
- 6. **World Teachers Day:** Teachers want to thank you for tomorrow's luncheon provided by the PAC. Very generous and much appreciated.
- 7. **After School Programs:** Several returning programs: Bricks for Kids, Art Mania, Minecraft, Lasermaster, Chess Club.
- 8. **New:** Chinese language program for 5 sessions.
- 9. **E-Forms and School Cash Online:** Chartwell has app. 45% of parents on board for School Cash Online. The cash online option is very convenient. App.60% of parents have signed off for e-forms. Please remind parents to go online to the new website under Parents Tab and sign off on all the consents.
- 10. **Upcoming Parent-Teacher conferences:** Oct. 24th and 27th there is a 2pm early dismissal for grades 1 to 7. Kindergartens already had their conferences. Important opportunity to connect with your child's teacher and learn how you can help.

DPAC Report -

There is no DPAC report since the first DPAC has not been conducted.

Committee Reports

1. Learning Commons (Library) Update. – Nessa van Bergen

Mme. Trudeau and Nessa had a very positive meeting with the school district's new Facility Manager in July, who came to the table with a more open mind. He confirmed the paint colour, carpet/flooring, lighting, and design elements can be more innovative than we were



previously advised and the District wants to be our partner in this process. They may also be able to find some money to support portions of the project. Mme. Trudeau would like to see the new Learning Commons becoming a show piece of Chartwell.

Without the strict restriction of design and vendors from the previous Facility Manager, CPAC is partnering with Art Institute of Vancouver Interior Design Students again to relook at the design and will give them updated design briefs.

We will receive a new set of design proposals from the Diploma Students at A.I. (including the entrance of school) in mid Dec. 2016. The final drawings, material lists, budget and construction schedule will then be prepared by the facility manager of the School District. The remodel construction is expected to be done in the summer of 2017, and to be potentially finished in multi-phase if need be.

In addition to the 25K earmarked from CPAC savings accounts, to date, over 18K has been raised through the Cheque Writing Campaign. The fundraising program is still open for future donations. We will need to look at more fundraising options this year now that we are able to have a more extensive design change.

2. Hot Lunch Update. - Natalia Rosales

Over 50% Chartwell families have placed Hot Lunch Order this term. There are new menu items like Chicken Curry Bowl, Gluten Free Pizza, Chicken Souvlaki, Green Salads.

With the approval from Mme. Trudeau, CPAC is planning to add one more Hot Lunch Day on either Monday or Tuesday.

Volunteer spots for this term have almost been fully taken. Thank you, parents.

3. Halloween Dance - Nessa van Bergen, on behalf of Tamzyn Jones

This annual fun event is coming back on Friday, October 28th. DJ Leo is coming back too!

Mme. Trudeau will work with teachers on Gym decoration. So far, we have 8 parents volunteered. **More volunteers are needed.**

The Halloween Dance form will be sent home next week. Payment can be made by Cash or Cheque
