What does CPAC do?

- Main focus is to support our children through participation at the school!
- Fundraise to pay for Physical Literacy programs like Dance In School and Badminton, Digital Safety and Sexual Health programs for students, and to purchase academic and sports equipment not covered by the school budget. (about \$35,000 per year!)
- Support Mme. Trudeau and her team of wonderful teachers and staff in implementing the School Plan
- We meet monthly on Thursday evenings at 7:00PM usually the first Thursday of every month.

What did CPAC do last year?

- Oversaw a renovation of the Learning Commons (formerly the Library) after fundraising and planning for 2 years. Cost: \$55,000 for CPAC's portion plus \$15,000 in furnishings.
- Sponsored Badminton Instructional Program, Dance In School, Aboriginal Cultural Performances Social Media Safety Education, and Sexual Health programs - plus Classroom Funds for each Teacher, ELL, Music, and Librarian. Cost: \$18,000
- Organized and Sponsored Family Halloween Dance, the only school in West Vancouver that has one
- In the past 5 years, the PAC has raised over \$250,000 to accomplish:
 - A new Library Commons space
 - The purchase of **30 Chromebooks** to increase Digital Access and Digital Literacy for the Gr 4/5 classes
 - Purchased digital projectors for every classroom and iPads for the primary grades use
 - New Gymnasium Sound System, new Volleyball Stanchions and Nets, and adjustable basketball hoops enabling access for the first time to Kindergarten thru Grade 3 students
 - New upgraded Drinking Fountains with water filters and the LCD screen in the front hallway
