Estimate for the remainder of year:

- Hot Lunch net revenue is estimated to finish around \$15,500 and includes \$4,640 in credits transferred from Liabilities, which were written off for users that did not log into the system or logged in but did not order this year.
- Overall Fundraising goal will be short \$2,200 but with HL write offs increasing the revenue and expenses that will be under budget, we will have a surplus of approx. \$8,000.
