If you are looking for an outdoor, physically active, and FUN summer camp for your students, check out Elevate Ultimate's Disc Golf and Ultimate Frisbee <u>summer camps!</u> The camps are running at Hugo Ray Park in West Vancouver and other locations on the North Shore every week of the summer.

Ultimate frisbee is a mix of basketball, soccer, and football, and involves lots of running and jumping. However, disc golf is a bit more of a cerebral sport where athletes try to get the disc in the basket in as few shots as possible. It is a great way to stay active without getting exhausted. <u>Both options</u> are very safe and are staffed by professional and fun coaches.
