Information: Just B4 Preschool at Chartwell in September!

Just B4 is a preschool program for 3 and 4 year old children who will be entering Kindergarten in September 2023. Using the Early Learning Framework and First Peoples Principles of Learning as our curriculum, our Early Childhood Educator will engage with children in play-based, experiential learning activities that support children's cognitive, physical, social, and emotional growth and development. Each day will include opportunities for free play, school community connection activities (e.g. library, gym, play with the Kindergarten class), story time, outside play, structured play-based learning activities, and snack (provided by families). Our planned hours of operation will be Monday –Friday from 9:00-11:45am with options for full or part-time attendance. Please note that we are NOT able to accept registrations until we are licenced by Vancouver Coastal Health and the District of West Vancouver.
