#### Traffic and Parking:

Parents are reminded to follow all traffic signs and procedures when entering or exiting the school. There is no left turn

at the top when exiting during pick up and drop off. This ensures safety for any students using the crosswalk and allows traffic to flow.

If your child is not ready when you are at the front of the line, you must exit out of the school to Chartwell Drive and re-enter the cue. You cannot simply rejoin the roundabout as this also causes a backup of traffic.

There is no parking in the staff parking area during drop off or pick up. Please park outside of the school and walk down to drop off or meet your child.
