Here are some strategies to assist with traffic flow:

- Carpool or find other transportation (i.e. walking, bike, or scooter).

 - Arrange a meeting place with your child on Chartwell Drive, Cambridge Place



- or Camelot Road.
- Drop off and pick-up students at the east end of the roundabout.
- If your child is not ready to be picked up, drive around for a second time or park on Chartwell Drive and walk to the school to connect with your child.
