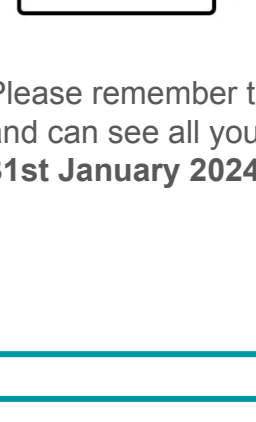
LOST AND FOUND

HOW TO ACTIVATE YOUR ACCOUNT ON MYEDUCATION BC IF YOU DO NOT HAVE AN ACCOUNT

All new parents will have received an email on November 3rd from sysadmin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca or admin@myeducation.gov.bc.ca providing a temporary one-time password – you would have been asked to create a new password immediately. If you did not receive an email check your junkmail first as it could be in that folder. We encourage you to set up the Family Portal on receipt of your email with a new password and practice navigating the site so that you are ready for Report Cards, ELL Reports and IEPs when they are published on 8th December.

Please remember that if you have an older child in high school, you already have an account and can see all your children on that one account. These reports will only be available until 31st January 2024, so we advise you to download and save for future reference.

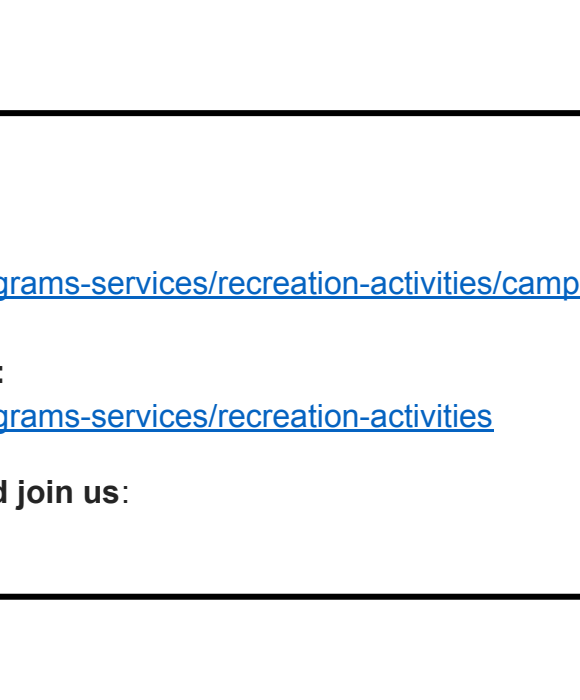

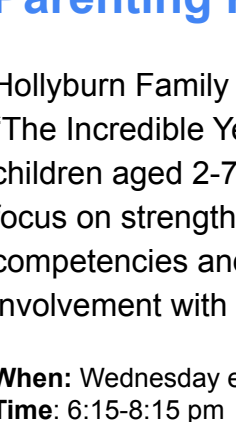

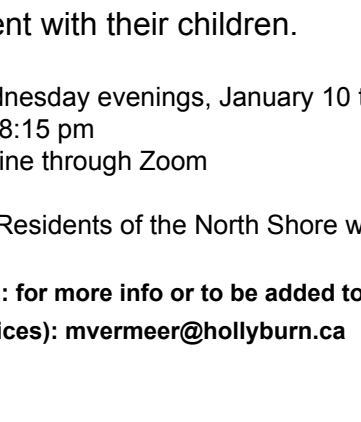

Just B4 is geared to children who are **not** currently enrolled in preschool, full-time childcare or other formal early learning programs.

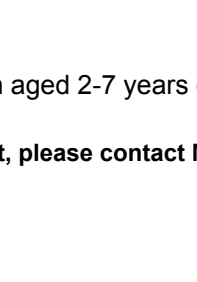
