## Grade 6 & 7 Marketplace

Students in grade 6 and 7 have been working hard this term exploring the world of entrepreneurship as a part of their ADST, math and Language Arts curriculum. Having developed an idea into a business plan, along with some market research, small groups of students have been busy working on manufacturing and marketing their products.

Next Thursday, February 22, classes are scheduled to attend the Marketplace, where if they choose, they can purchase something from the grade 6 and 7 students. Products include friendship bracelets, slime, bookmarks and more.

Money raised will be used to reimburse students for the materials they needed to buy and all profits will be donated to a charity of the students' choosing.


