Dear Chartwell Families,

Each year, one of the most memorable and meaningful experiences for our Grade 7 students is Outdoor School, and we're thrilled to share that **next year's Grade 7s** will be attending the incredible Keats Camp in early October.

Outdoor School is more than just a few days away from the classroom—it's a powerful opportunity for students to bond as a group, build confidence, and develop the teamwork and leadership skills that will serve them well in their final year of elementary school and beyond. Our Grade 7 students remember Outdoor School as a highlight of their time at Chartwell.

We know that sending your child away overnight can feel like a big step, especially if they haven't had that experience before. However, we strongly believe that these opportunities to build independence and resilience are essential. Stepping out of their comfort zones in a safe, supportive environment helps children grow socially and emotionally, and we often see this growth translate into greater maturity and academic engagement back at school.

Here are just a few of the benefits of attending Outdoor School:

- Stronger peer relationships that foster a more inclusive and collaborative classroom environment.
- Team-building challenges that encourage creative problem-solving and cooperation.
- Leadership development as students take on new responsibilities and support one another.
- Connection to nature that supports wellbeing, curiosity, and environmental stewardship.
- Confidence and independence gained through new experiences and personal achievements.

To support families in learning more, we will be hosting a Grade 7 Outdoor School Information Session on **Thursday, May 30 at 3:00 PM in the school library**. If you are unsure about giving consent for your child to attend, we strongly encourage you to come to this session. We'll be sharing trip details, answering questions, and discussing how we help ensure all students feel safe and supported during their time away.

We are so excited to continue this Chartwell tradition and hope your child will be part of it. The impact of Outdoor School is profound—and we can't wait to see the strong, connected leaders our Grade 7 students will become as a result.

Grade 6 & 7 Chartwell Band Program 2025/2026: Registration Now Open!

Dear Parents of Grade 5 & 6 Students,

Registration is now open to join the Chartwell Band Program for the 2025/26 School year by visiting <u>https://westvancouverschools.ca/programs/elementary-band/</u> or <u>CLICKING HERE</u>. All students currently in Grade 5 and their families are encouraged to consider this special music opportunity. Grade 6 families register at the same above link. Register before May 31, 2025 and pay this years rate of \$390 for the year. On June 1, 2025 the fee increases to \$425.
