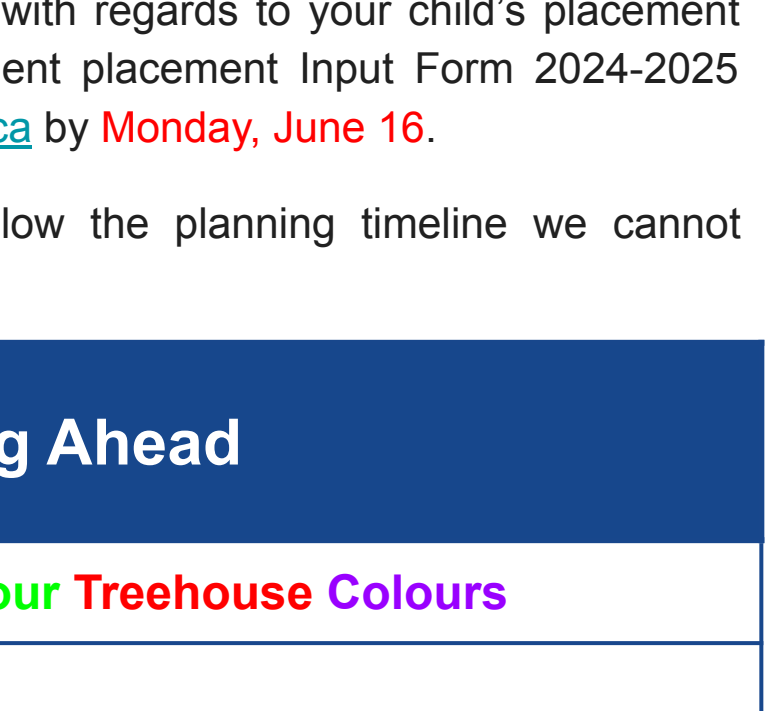
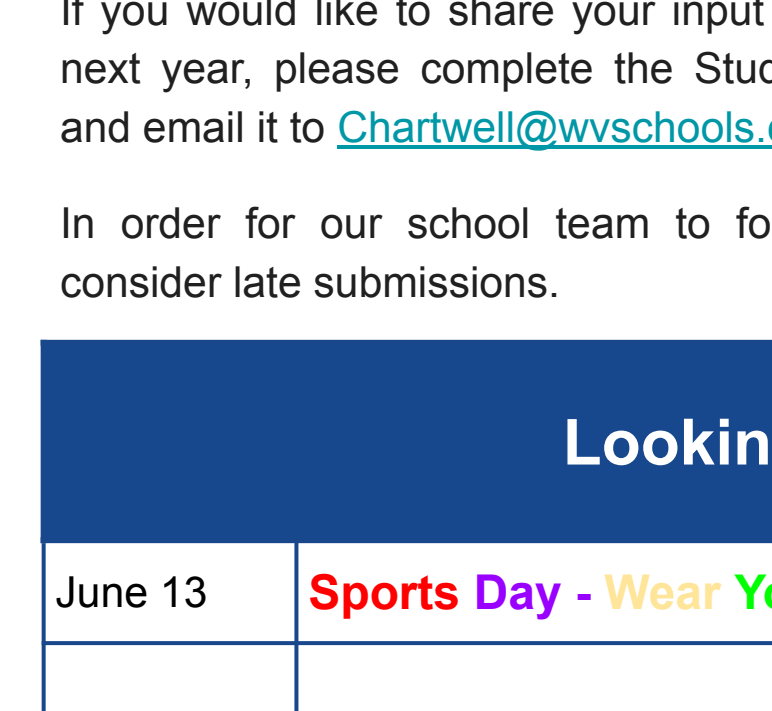
Dear Chartwell Families,

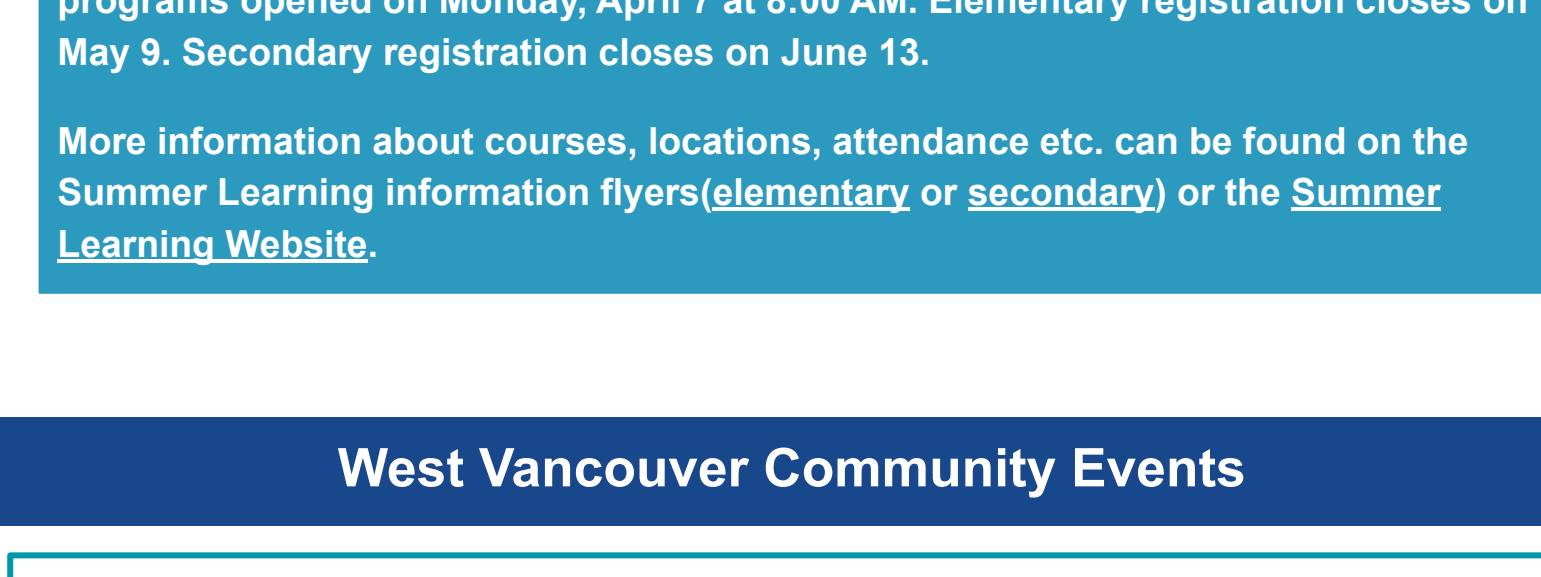

Planning Ahead: Enrollment for 2025–2026

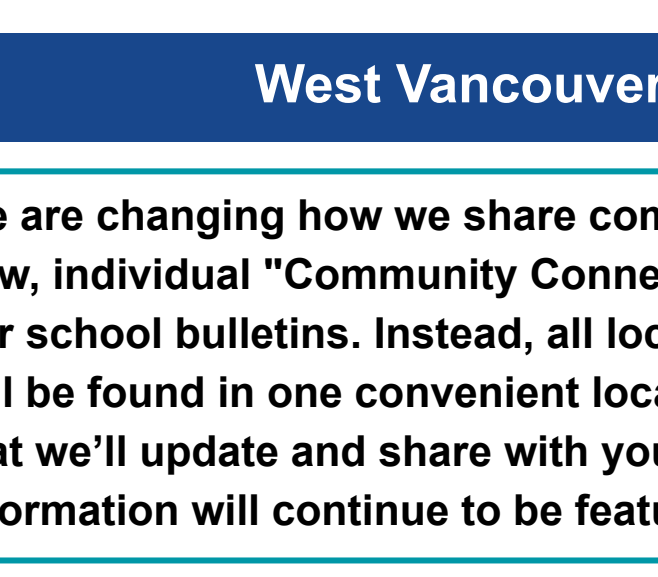

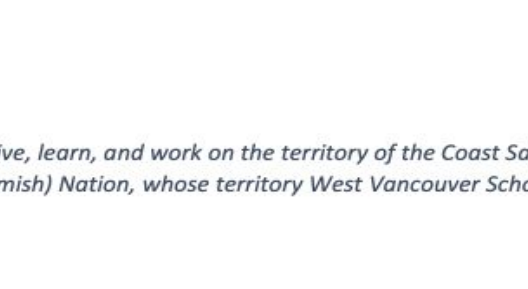
