Dear Chartwell Families,

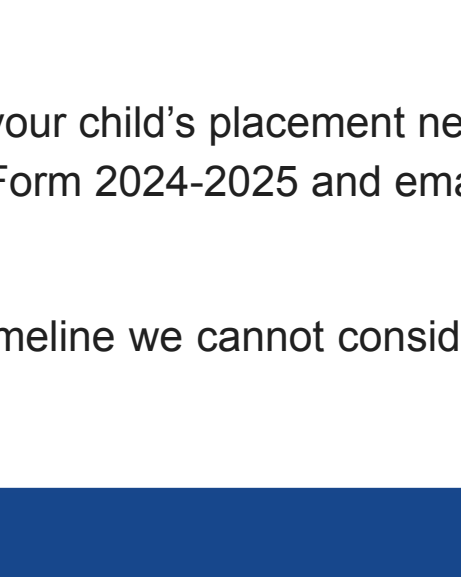
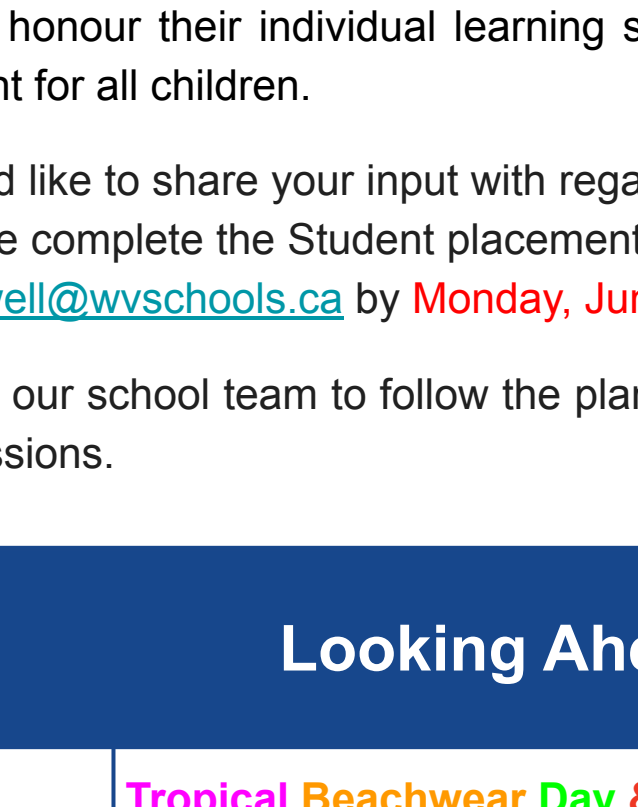

**Supplies will be sent to the school** with your child's name. You do **not** need to send them to your home.

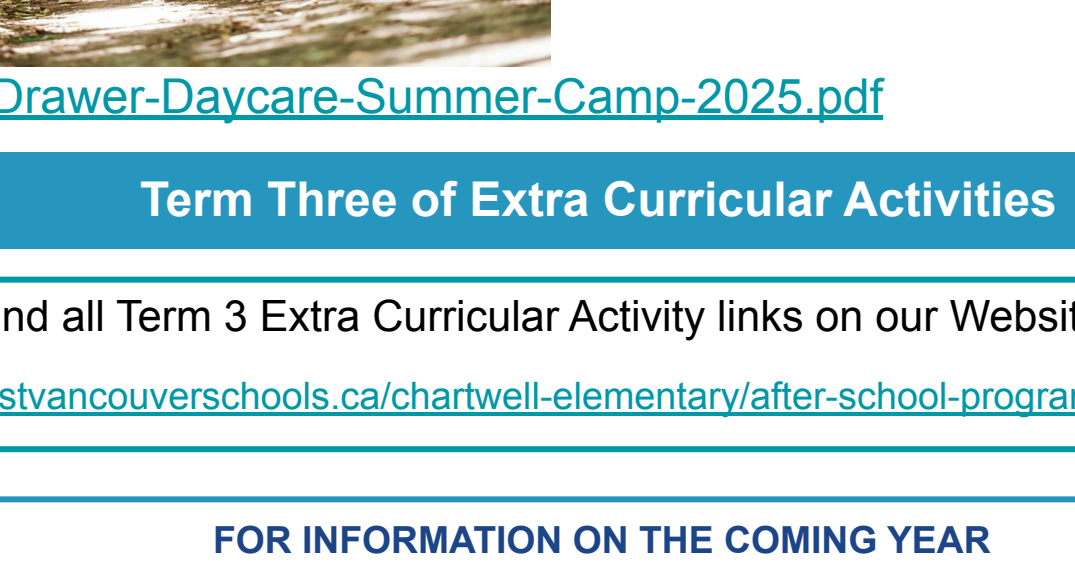
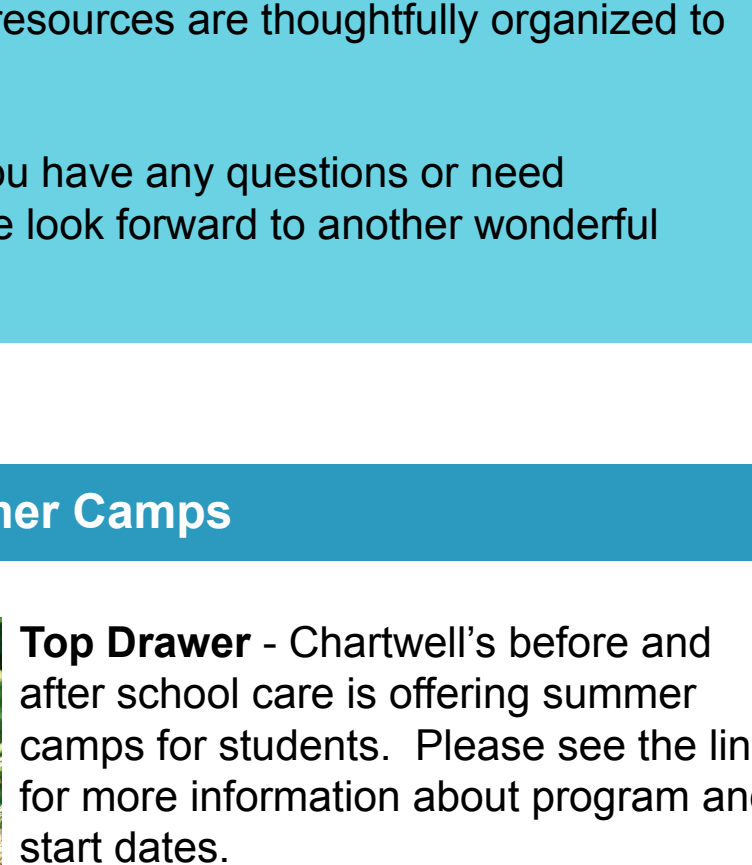

### Planning Ahead: Enrollment for 2025–2026

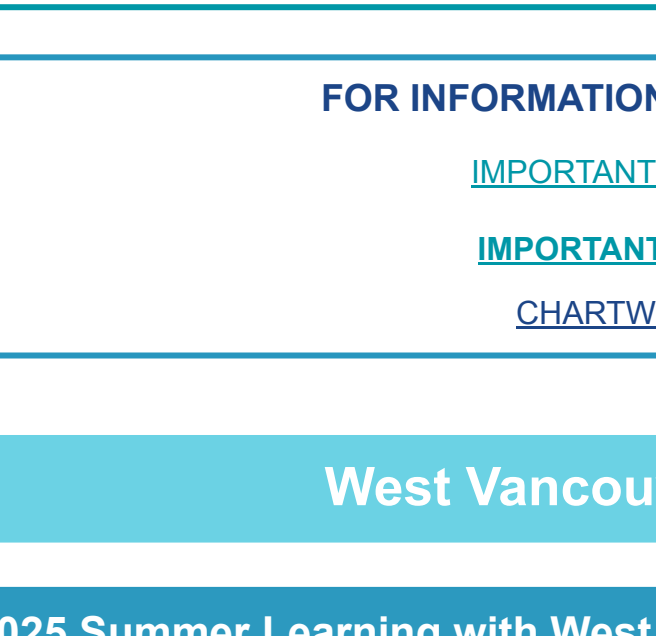
