Students Returning to Chartwell 2024- 2025

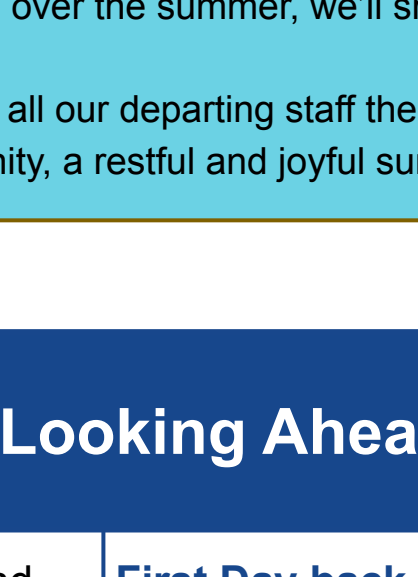

Chartwell Reminders

DEVICE EXPECTATIONS 2024–2025

In January 2024, the Province announced new guidelines to support student safety and well-being by limiting personal digital device use in schools. This includes items such as cell phones, laptops, tablets, and smartwatches. These expectations remain in place for the 2025–2026 school year.

Most West Vancouver schools, including Chartwell, already have technology use guidelines. While personal devices can enhance learning when used intentionally, they can also distract from instruction, disrupt focus, and interfere with the classroom environment. We've seen great success this past year by limiting device use, and we will continue with these expectations moving forward.

In September:

Personal devices may only be used with direct permission from a teacher or administrator and must support student learning. Accommodations will be made for medical, health, or accessibility needs.

When this applies:

- **Elementary Schools:** Throughout the entire school day, including recess and before/after school

To support this at home, we ask families to refrain from calling or texting students during school hours. Students should not feel pressure to respond to messages during the day. Please help us maintain a focused and respectful learning environment. For any urgent matters, please contact the school office.

We appreciate your continued support as we uphold this important guideline for the benefit of all students.

To make things easier for families, we have an online school supply ordering system. You can see the supply lists and order everything in one place. This is often cheaper and faster for families.

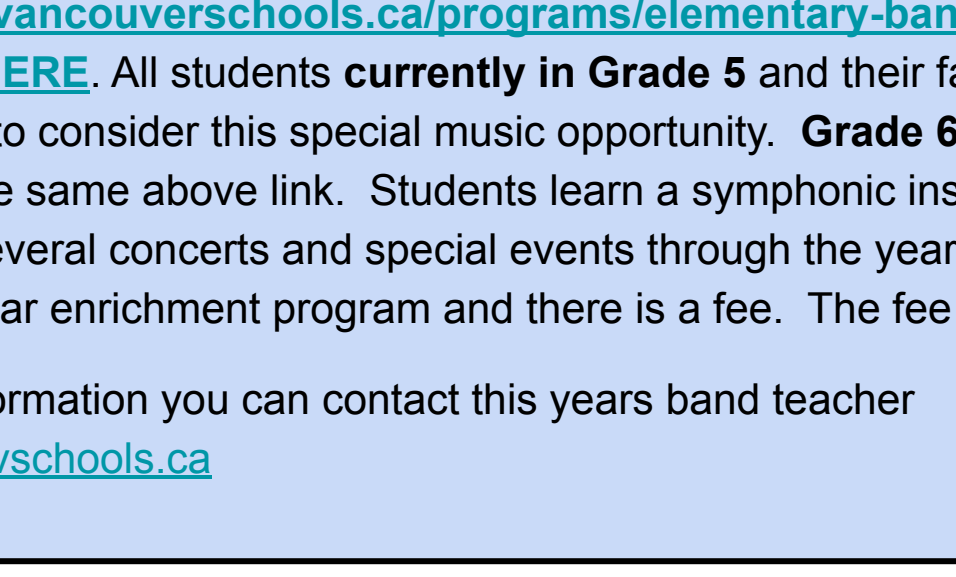
All the items on the list are required. But if you already have some of the *optional* items (in good condition), you can use those instead.

Planning Ahead: Enrollment for 2025–2026

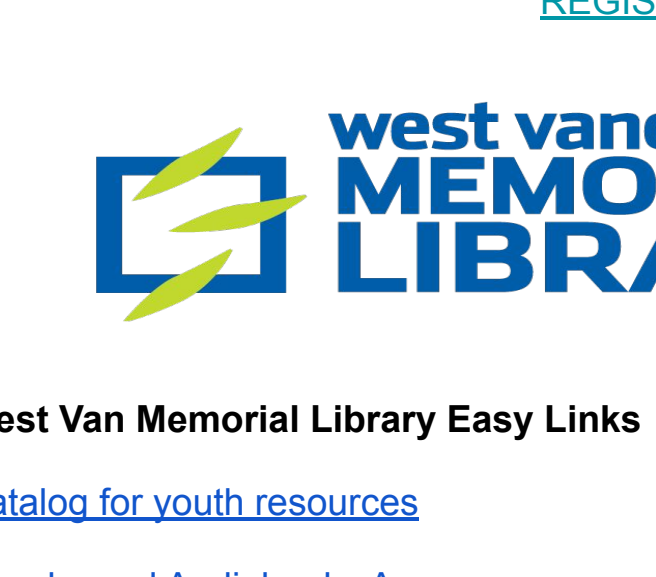

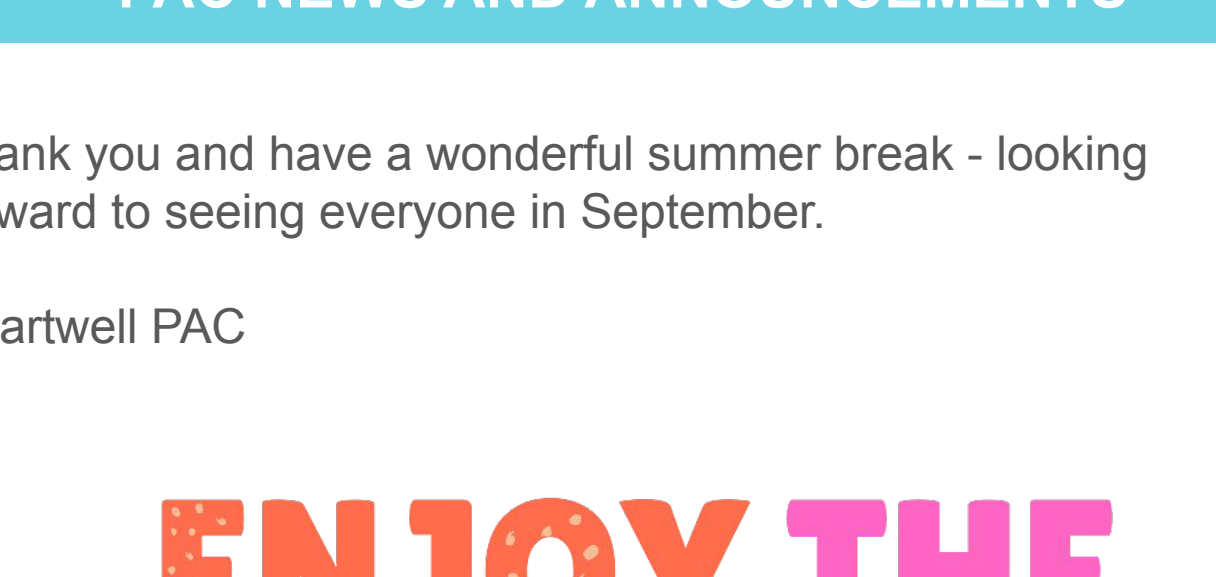

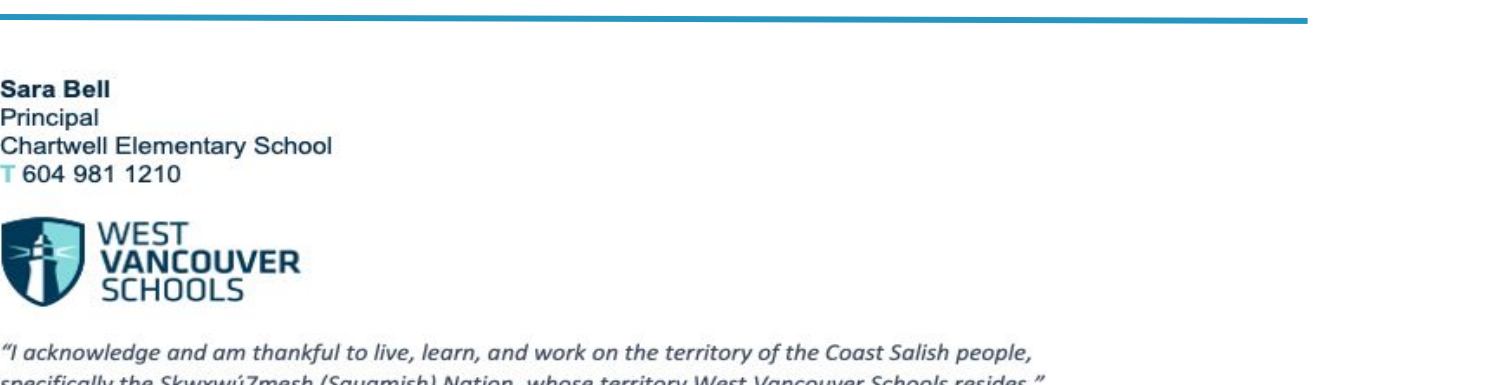
