NEW BUSINESS

VOTE PAC BUDGET for 2025-2026 SCHOOL YEAR:

- Indigenous Education budget to be changed to First Aid (still \$400 fall short)
- PAC Stationary budget to be included in Admin & General Expenses; New budget for Admin and General Expenses is now \$300.
- Cultural Events of \$1000 is budgeted for events such as the Lunar New Year and Nowruz. Events Committee should make attentive plans at the beginning of the school year for the PAC to decide how much should be distributed to the event as a kick start.
- Appreciation Gifts: Gift cards are the top choice. Roughly \$30 to \$35 per gift card for each staff. There are 37 staffs in total for current year.
- Teachers Day to be renamed as Teachers Appreciation Day.

VOTE TO RETAIN SENTINEL SECONDARY SCHOLARSHIP:

Supporting Sentinel with \$600 scholarship for two Grade 12 graduating students (formerly Chartwell students) has long been a tradition for Chartwell. For this year and in the future, we will continue with this tradition. In addition, we are suggesting inviting the scholarship recipients,

who are former Chartwell students, to give a speech at the Gr 7 Graduation Ceremony. In the past, some scholarships were not even cashed out. So we are also suggesting that if the scholarship is not cashed out by a certain date, the scholarship fund will be donated on behalf of the scholarship recipients to the charities, the children's hospital from Chartwell Elementary School.

Vote on Gym Decoration for Graduation Event of \$450.00

- Mainly for the red carpet
- Motion to move forward with the PAC funding \$450.00 for the gym decoration for the Grad event. All in favor. The motion is adopted.
