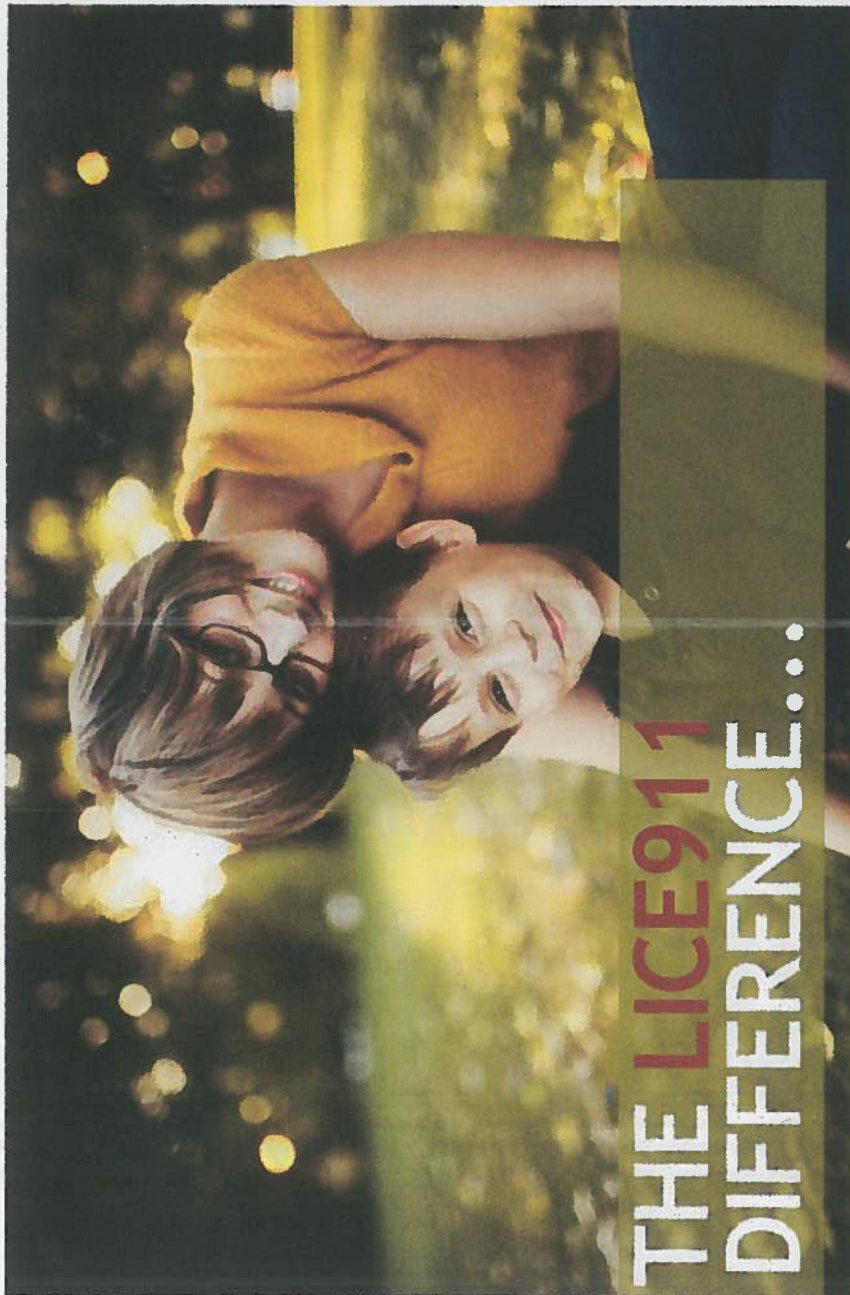

Why we're different...

We use the **Wet-Combing Method** to break up their life cycle. Head lice cannot become resistant to this method and all you need is a good comb and some hair conditioner to be successful. Olive oil, Vaseline, mayonaisse or tea tree oil will work just as well, but hair conditioner is a lot easier to wash out afterwards! This method is most successful when working with a good quality comb. Look for a comb that has metal teeth at least 2" long. The teeth are rigid, cannot be bent easily and the handle is sealed into the teeth of the comb. Good combs will save you hours of nitpicking. We love the **LiceMeister© comb** because it will take them out even if you can't see them!

The first combout removes most of the live lice and nits that are on the head. Any lice or nits remaining are easily removed with each subsequent comb out and long before they can reproduce. Just schedule your combouts every 3 days for 3 weeks and remember to use conditioner every time you comb out. This method will break up their life cycle and guarantee complete removal.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q What are the signs and symptoms of head lice?

A Signs include: frequent scratching or feeling like there's something moving in the hair. Scratching will increase as the infestation develops.

Q Do you need chemicals to treat lice?

A No. All the treatments work the same way and that is by only killing the live lice...they do nothing to the nits or baby lice. Even if you use a treatment, you will still need to comb out to guarantee complete removal.

Q How do I check for head lice?

A Head lice are very small and move very quickly. It's easier to confirm an infestation by finding their nits (eggs). Get a good light and magnifying glass or visor. Start by parting the hair and looking closely at the root. Look for tiny, oval shaped nits cemented to one side of the hair shaft Nits stick like glue and are very hard to remove.

Q What do I do if I've tried everything and they keep coming back?
