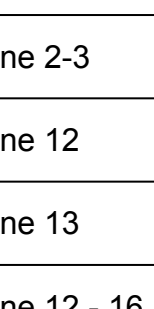

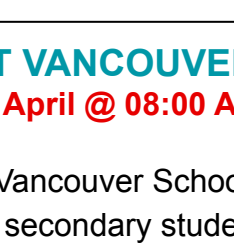
WEST VANCOUVER COMMUNITY CULTURAL FESTIVAL

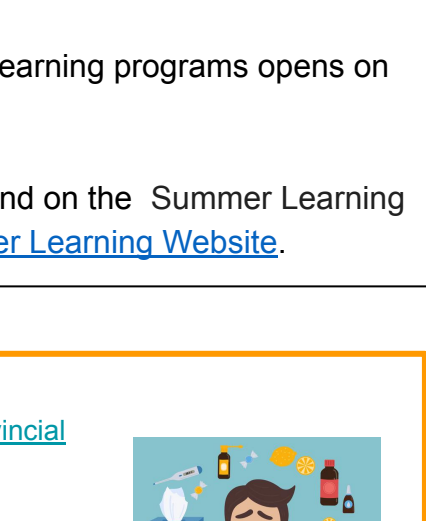
LOST AND FOUND

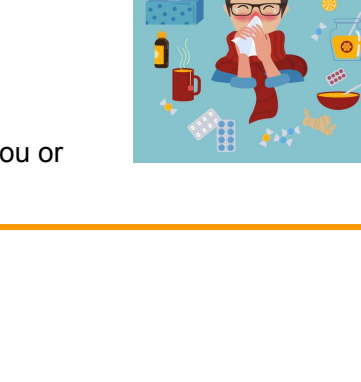

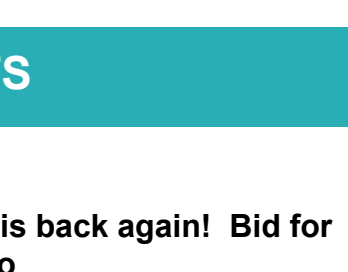

- We are a mask friendly school and we respect and support each person's choice. Information is available here at the [BC Centre for Disease Control](#).

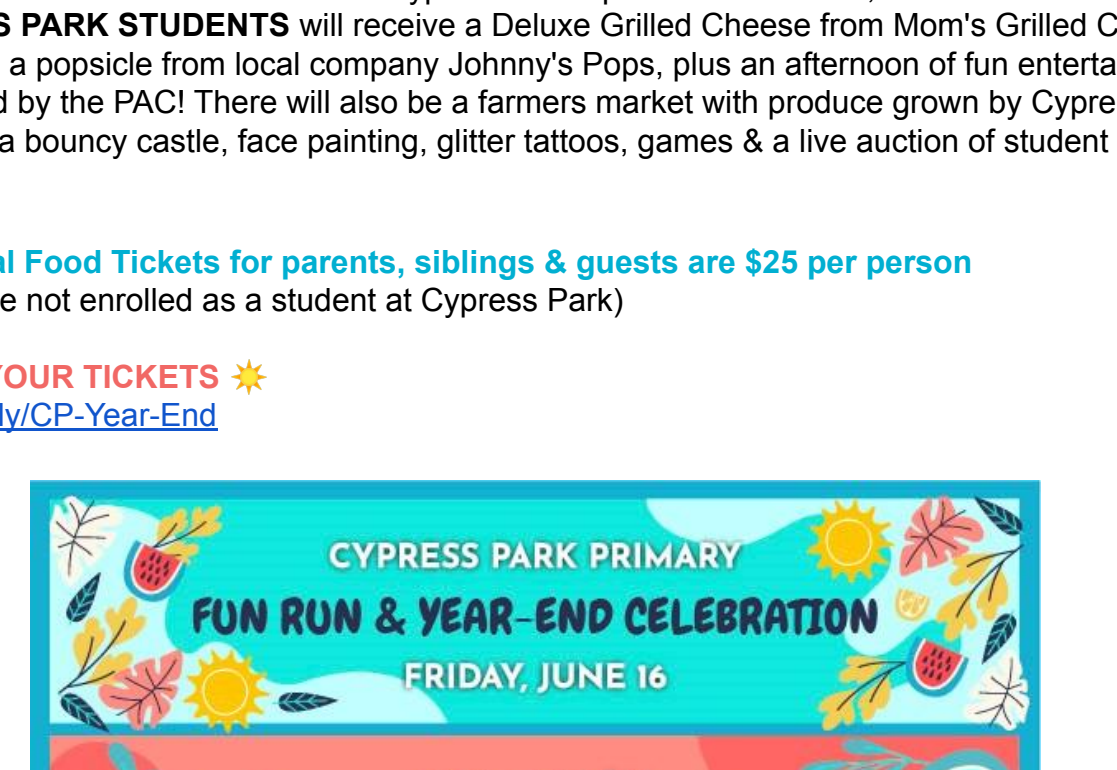
It remains important to practice health awareness and do a [daily health check](#) if you or your child is feeling unwell.
