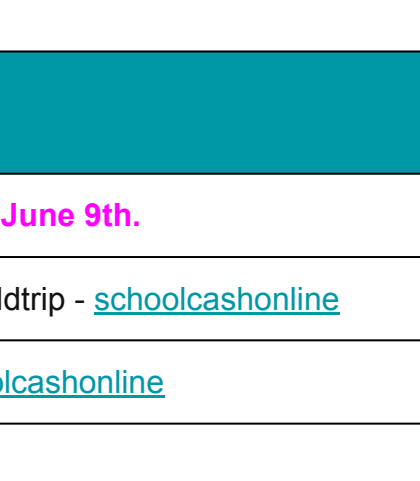

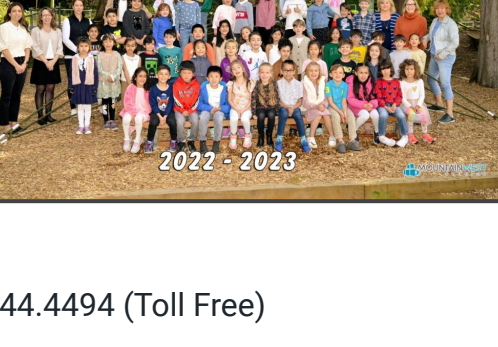
LOOKING AHEAD

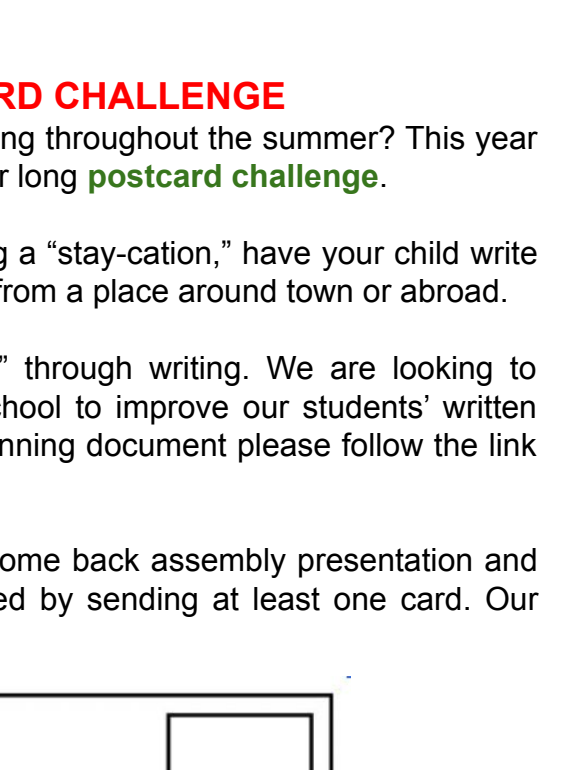

If you are travelling this summer or even if you are planning a "staycation," have your child write postcards or letters from different destinations. This can be from a place around town or abroad.

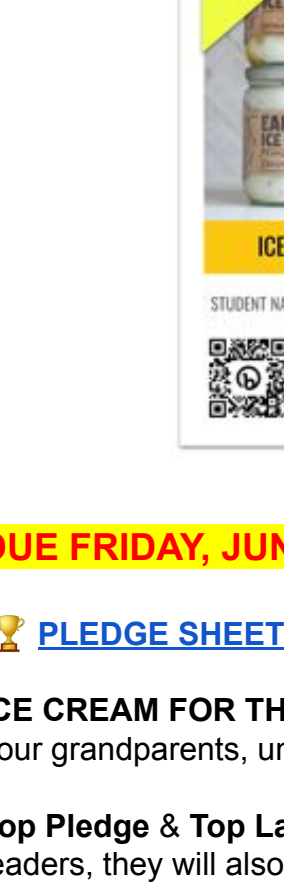
Our school FESL goal is to "Connect and Communicate" through writing. We are looking to provide opportunities for authentic writing at home and school to improve our students' written expression.

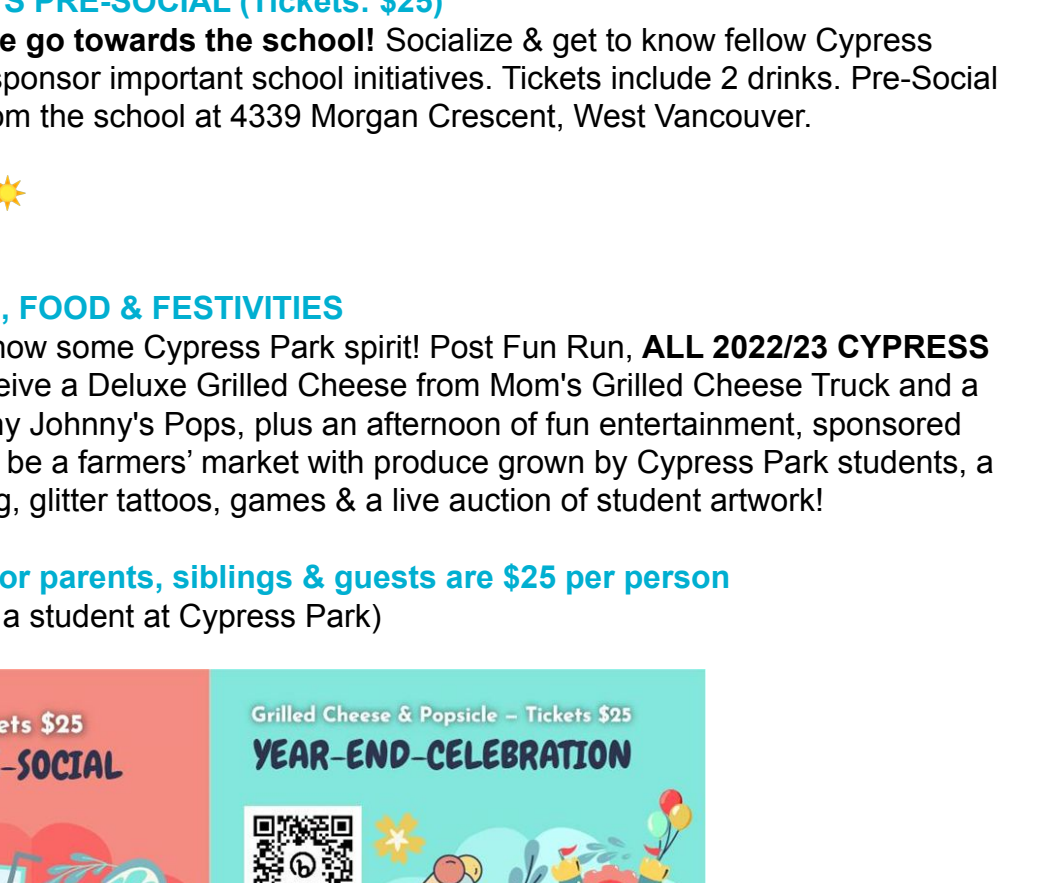
