RUN CLUB vs. FUN RUN - WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

Run Club or KM Club is every Tuesday and Thursday from 8:10-8:30 where students run the perimeter of the school and collect popsicle sticks (6 = 1km). The kms are tracked in class and students can earn ribbons at the 10k, 20k, 30k, 40k, and 50k milestones. They will receive the ribbons as they reach the kms. The last day of Run Club will be Thursday, June 13th. Teachers are tracking attendance each morning. To encourage participation and consistency, those that made a commitment to attend every session since the beginning on May 7th will receive a certificate for their achievement.

The **Fun Run** is a one day, PAC sponsored event where students are encouraged to collect pledges from friends and family members. On Friday, June 14th at 2:00pm, students will meet outside on the grass field and begin running laps. 
