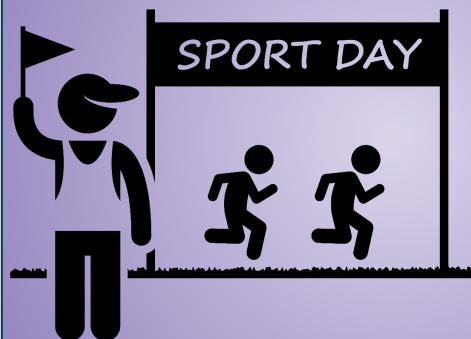

KM CLUB vs. FUN RUN - WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

KM Club is every Tuesday and Thursday from 8:10-8:30 where students run the perimeter of the school field and collect popsicle sticks (5 = 1km). The kms are tracked in class and students can earn ribbons at the 10k, 20k, 30k, 40k, and 50k milestones. They will receive the ribbons as they reach the kms. The last day KM Club will be Thursday, June 12th.

The **Fun Run** is a one day, PAC sponsored event where students are encouraged to collect pledges from friends and family members. On Friday, June 13th at 2:10pm, students will meet outside on the grass field and begin running laps. 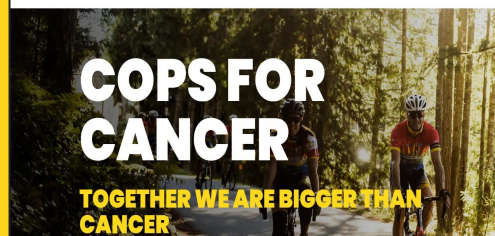
