To begin unpacking the idea that living things share needs, we used our observation skills to check in on our Scarlet Runner beans—and then planted them! We also observed the concept of change through our celery experiment and our growing beans.











## 2025 SUMMER LEARNING with WEST VANCOUVER SCHOOLS
