We are very excited to be welcoming our students back in person on Monday. During this first week staff have reviewed, revised and enhanced all provincial, district and school specific safety measures to ensure we are doing everything we can to keep the learning 'in person' here at Eagle Harbour.

TYPES OF SCHOOL CLOSURES

To help clarify reasons for closure you may have been hearing in the news, we have provided some definitions below. In the event of either of these closures, the school and school district would provide families with more communication about this process and timing.

- 1. Health closure of a school, which is determined by the local health authority due to the COVID19 case count in, or related to, a school.
- 2. Functional closure of a school, which is determined by the school or school district due to a lack of

staff to provide the required level of teaching, supervision, support, and/or custodial to ensure the health and safety of students. This would likely be due to a high absenteeism of all staff or certain employees required for a school to function and the inability to replace those absences.



READY FOR ANY WEATHER







Winter is definitely here! Please be sure your child has a 'just in case' change of clothing at school and send them to school in weather appropriate gear as the children will be outside for recess and lunch in all but the most extreme inclement weather.

Our School District endeavours to keep schools open on regular instructional days, including those with accumulating snowfall (<u>Weather Closures and Procedures</u>), however, the final decision to send students to school resides with the parent or guardian since they are most familiar with the specific road and weather conditions around their home and community.

Any decision to close schools will be made by the Superintendent and is based on the safety of students and staff. Parents, students, and staff will be informed of the Superintendent's decision, ideally by 6:00am on the day of the closure, via:
