EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS BASICS (VIRTUAL) FREE VIRTUAL EVENT Wednesday, May 4th 7pm - 8pm



Earth's climate is changing. As average temperatures rise, acute hazards such as heat waves and floods grow in frequency and severity, and chronic hazards, such as drought and rising sea levels, intensify. We've experienced two such events in the last year alone - are you ready for the next Emergency?

The North Shore Emergency Management (NSEM) in conjunction with the West Vancouver Memorial Library is holding a 1-hour online "Emergency Preparedness Basics" presentation on Wednesday, May 4th starting at 7:00 PM. Register online to learn more about how to prepare for potential hazards faced by residents of the North Shore.

Participants will learn about creating an emergency preparedness plan and emergency kit as well as learn about <u>ALERTABLE</u>, a multi-purpose emergency communication service used by NSEM to send alerts to residents, businesses, and visitors during critical events.

NSEM is an inter-municipal agency whose mission is to serve and support the North Shore municipalities and citizens in preparing for, responding to, and recovering from emergencies and disasters.
