UBC PHENOMENAL PHYSICS SUMMER CAMPS

Registration is now open for the **UBC Phenomenal Physics summer camps** happening this July 18-22 and July 25-29, 2022!

After a two year hiatus, we are excited to be running in-person camps suitable for Elementary-age students again! Camps focus on STEM and Discovery covering basic physics and engineering concepts in:
