IMPORTANT NEW TALENT SHOW INFORMATION:

All students must confirm with Ms. Hardern what their act is, (either in-person or via email: ehardern@wvschools.ca) including the title/artist for any music being used in their performance by 2:35pm on JUNE 10th for screening and school approval. Students are strongly encouraged to perform live if at all possible.

Recorded music (for live dance/gymnastic performances, etc) must be submitted to Ms. Hardern by **Monday June 20th at 2:35pm on a USB stick or via Google Drive.**

If your child's talent absolutely cannot be performed live, (for example, skills such as horseback riding, skateboarding, digital art projects, etc) they may submit their act by video. **Videos are limited to a MAXIMUM of 3 minutes** long and may be further edited if necessary.

All video submissions must be submitted to Ms. Hardern on a USB stick or via Google Drive by Monday June 20th at 2:35pm.

Rehearsals for all talent show participants will take place during the week of June 20th-24th. Students are expected to have all necessary supplies/instruments/music at school each day.

UBC PHENOMENAL PHYSICS SUMMER CAMPS

Registration is now open for the **UBC Phenomenal Physics summer camps** happening this July 18-22 and July 25-29, 2022!
