Parents, you will no doubt be pleased to know that we had a very successful 'ShakeOut BC' earthquake and fire drill this morning. As you are likely already aware, we live in a very geologically-active zone and as such West Vancouver Schools all have rigorous and mandatory fire and earthquake drill schedules. All residents are also strongly encouraged to inform themselves and develop home plans to be 'better prepared so we can be less scared'. Please <u>CLICK HERE</u> to access more information regarding earthquake preparedness.

Speaking about Earthquake/Emergency Preparedness ... the hard copy emergency release forms sent out earlier in September are a very important part of our preparedness protocols. Please be sure to complete them if you have not already done so, and if you did not have any alternates to list because you did not yet know anyone to ask, please send us names for alternates asap. This should be persons that could pick up your child and keep them safe for up to 72 hours. Preferably within walking or a short drive of the school.

VERY IMPORTANT STUDENT SAFETY AT DROP OFF

We have received expressions of concern about student safety with respect to traffic at pick up and drop off times in the circle. Please make sure you drop your student off from the passenger side of your vehicle and ask them to walk on the sidewalk around the perimeter to get to the door. There have been several **dangerous** instances of children running through/across the lot as cars come and go.


